XMAS AND NEW YEAR EMERGENCY COVER

Our Contractors will supply an emergency service over the Xmas & New year periods. This will commence on Thursday 24th Dec' from 12.00pm up to Tuesday 29th Dec' 9.00am, and again from 12:00pm on Thursday 31st December - 9am Monday 4th January 2021. During these times please call the Out of Hours Emergency Repairs line on 020 7926 6666.

Please ensure that before you call the it is a genuine emergency.

Examples of an emergency include: Flooding, Total power Extinction, Total Loss of Heating and Hot Water, and toilet blockages, . **Non emergencies include:** Partial heating loss, no hot water where an electric Immersion tank is present, individual light fitting / switch is broken, minor water leaks, such as taps or sink traps, basin, sink or bath blockages. Minor Issues should be reported on any normal working day at the office.

Following this simple guide will ensure that all parties can enjoy the festive season.

Pay your rent before it's spent

Easy ways to pay your rent:

Credit/debit card: At the CETRA Housing Office 27 Cedars Road SW4 0PN or by calling 020 7926 7555.

Cash: At the Cashiers Office, London Borough Lambeth Town Hall, 18 Brixton Hill SW2 1RW (please check with Lambeth Council that the cashiers office is currently open)

Swipe card: You can pay using your swipe card at any pay point.

Bank transfer: Please use your account reference number as reference for payment.

Estate Parking Arrangements Reminder

We would like to remind all Residents that Parking enforcement on the Cedars Estate has started from 7th December, therefore we now require Residents and their visitors to use Permits. If your Permit has ran out and you need to renew a permit, please send your documentation via <u>cedars@lambeth.gov.uk</u>. If you would like to buy a daily parking Permit, we ask Residents to contact us in advance to make arrangements to visit the office and purchase the permit with your credit or debit card.

Your <u>Residents</u> parking permit from now on will be added to digital platform so you are no longer required to display it in your vehicle. <u>Residents parking permit are valid for 1 year so we advise residents to make a note of it's expiry date once you receive confirmation of it's renewal</u>. A Visitors parking permit will be issued as normal and must be placed on your vehicle's dashboard. PLEASE NOTE; CETRA cannot get involved in any cases whereby a PCN has been issued to vehicles so please ensure your have obtained your parking permits ASAP so as to avoid receiving a PCN.

CALLING ALL PET OWNERS

Seeking permission to have a dog

It has come to CETRA's attention that there are some Residents on the Cedars Estate who have a dog but have not requested permission to have one. It is part of your Tenancy/Lease Conditions that you must request permission to have a dog in your property. Failure to do so means you are in breach of your Tenancy Agreement. We kindly ask that those who have NOT requested permission to have a dog do so in writing to the CETRA Housing Office immediately. Generally permission is granted providing that the dog isn't registered as a dangerous dog, the dog is micro chipped, insured for liability and kept on a lead at all times when in communal areas. PLEASE NOTE: If you fail to register for permission to have a dog and CETRA receive complaints in relation to your dog you run the risk of CETRA denying any retrospective permission

Have the dog on the lead while walking it on the Estate

There has been an increasing number of complaints relating to dog owners allowing their dogs to walk on the estate without the lead. Whilst we understand not all cases are linked to our residents, we must stress that it is a bye law and part of the terms and conditions of the dog ownership declaration that all residents with a dog must be kept on a lead at ALL times whilst in the communal areas of the Estate.



Clean up after your dog

There have been a number of complaints about dog fouling on the

estate. We urge all residents to be vigilant and try to give CETRA a detailed description of the owner and dog to help us catch the perpetrator. Where possible if a date/time could be supplied we can also check our CCTV footage to see if we can identify the culprit. A £75 fine will be issued if caught.

SUBLETTING OF CEDARS ESTATE GARAGES

It has come to our attention that there are garages on the Cedars Estate that are potentially being sublet to third parties. May we remind residents it is a condition of your garage tenancy NOT to sublet the garage.

If we find that a resident has sublet their garage we will be forced to take back the garage immediately and the Resident will no longer be allowed to rent a garage again in the future.

Please note; if CETRA has reason to believe a garage is being sublet we can request an immediate inspection of the garage to check if the garage has been sublet and take the necessary action if the garage has been sublet.

If any residents are aware of any garages being illegally sublet they can notify CETRA privately and we will investigate.

FESTIVE GATHERINGS

To anyone having visitors over the holidays please remember as well as enjoying yourselves to be mindful and considerate of your neighbours and to ask your guests to do the same. CETRA understands that there will be festivities on the estate and that this will increase levels of disturbance but try to be considerate with the other residents and please do not let gatherings spill onto the balconies or communal areas. HAVE A GREEN CHRISTMAS

Over the Christmas period we understand Residents are bound to accumulate additional quantities of rubbish/boxes .In order to assist the Estate Cleaning Staff and Lambeth's Streetcare, we would ask for all Residents to make sure they recycle any recyclable rubbish/boxes in the Environmental bins provided.

We would like to remind Residents that the recycling bins are for **INDIVIDUAL** recyclable items only. Black household rubbish bags, plastic bags as well as orange/white recycling bags **CANNOT** be disposed of in the recycling bins. If anything other than individual items are disposed of the collection team will **NOT** empty the bins which will cause the bins to overflow and attract vermin to the Estate!

Please think of others when disposing of Rubbish on the Estate and help keep the Cedars Estate clean.
