Tenants are reminded that in **April 2023** ALL Housing rents were increased by 7% this year and, the figure you should pay this year either weekly/monthly is **HIGHER** than last year.

If you are a Tenant who is paying an incorrect figure please could you kindly amend your payment amount **ASAP** to avoid building any rent arrears on your rent account.

ELECTRICAL VEHICLE CHARGING- CEDARS ESTATE



Currently, surveys are underway to evaluate the viability of 2 locations within Cedars Estate.

PETS IN CEDARS ESTATE

It is a requirement of all Lease/Tenancy Agreements that any Resident wishing to keep a dog OR cat in their property must obtain permission from CETRA Housing BEFORE acquiring the dog OR cat.

CETRA are becoming increasingly aware that there are a number of dogs on the Estate whose owners have NOT received permission to keep them in their property.

If you are a Resident who already has a dog in the property but have not requested permission to do so you can apply for retrospective permission, but this must be done **IMMEDIATELY**. To be eligible to keep a dog in the property the dog must be microchipped (proof of this will be required), insured for liability (proof of this will be required), wear identification tags at all times and be kept on a lead at all times when in the communal areas of the Estate.

When considering requests to keep a dog in the property, the size and breed of the dog will be taken into account as well as the level of your property (Ground/1st Floor and any available garden space) and the make up of your household (to ensure the household does not become overcrowded by keeping a dog). PLEASE NOTE; the above affects all Residents (Lambeth Tenants, Leaseholders and Sub-Tenants of Leaseholders) so if you are a Leaseholder that rents out their property you MUST ensure that your Sub-Tenants are aware of this procedure.
