FALCONRY PROGRAMME ON THE ESTATE



Following our previous newsletter, we mentioned that there has been a large increase in pigeons on the estate and as a result CETRA are currently undertaking a **Falconry pest control programme** to try and decrease the amount of birds on the Estate.

We would like to remind all residents to refrain from leaving food waste around the estate or feeding pigeons. If residents continue to feed the birds they will not decrease, and will in fact increase making the falconry programme a pointless exercise.

We ask residents to be vigilant and report any sightings of anyone seen feeding pigeons so that we can take the appropriate action.
